Closing date: Saturday 3rd March 2012

1. Entries will be accepted from any IAC member, an affiliated club or any member of an affiliated club within the CEMRIAC region. Entries must be the work of the entrant or club and have been completed within five years of the festival date. Entry implies compliance with these rules.
2. Entries must not have won major, national or international movie competitions prior to the festival, and must not have been entered for any previous CEMRIAC competition.
3. Entries must not have been produced for profit or commercial gain.
4. The maximum permitted running time for each entry is 20 minutes. In addition, the total duration of all entries submitted by one competitor must not exceed 30 minutes.
5. Entries are acceptable in the following formats: VHS, S-VHS, Mini DV, DVD, Memory Stick (except Micro) and SD memory card. If an entry does not play correctly on CEMRIAC equipment the entrant will be asked for the video in an alternative format. Only entries that play satisfactorily on CEMRIAC equipment will be accepted.
6. A completed entry form must accompany each entry, together with the fees for each entrant. Individual IAC members must quote their membership number to qualify for the reduced entry fee.
7. All sponsorship must be declared.
8. **Copyright material cannot be accepted** unless appropriate clearance has been obtained. This includes music, commercially produced film footage and photographs. Evidence of clearance may be required. Please note that entries from individuals are not covered by the IAC licences issued to their clubs.
9. All entrants agree to their entry being shown at the festival, either in full or as extracts.
10. If it is necessary to limit the number of entries at the festival, the priority stated on the entry form will determine which entries are not included in the competition (commencing with the lowest priority). If this does not reduce the number sufficiently, other entries will be excluded from the competition after pre-judging. Entry fees for excluded movies will be refunded and they will be eligible for entry in a future CEMRIAC competition.
11. CEMRIAC reserve the right to refuse or withdraw any entry without giving a reason.
12. Winners of the awards listed below will be presented with glass trophies which they may keep.
13. CEMRIAC reserve the right to withhold any trophy.
14. Whilst every care will be taken of an entrant's property, CEMRIAC cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage. Wherever possible entries should be collected at the end of the festival. Entries returned by post are sent at the entrant's risk.
15. The £2.50 for postage of a trophy is refunded if no trophy is awarded to that entrant.
16. In the event of any dispute the Competition Officer's decision is final.

These are the Trophies:

- **Overall Winner** awarded to the best entry.
- **2nd & 3rd Trophies** awarded to the runners up.
- **Sound Trophy** awarded to the entry with the most imaginative use of sound.
- **Editing Trophy** awarded to the entry with the most creative editing.
- **First Time Winner Award** awarded to the best entry by a film-maker who has not won any award at this festival or in any CEMRIAC festival.
- **Young Film-maker Trophy** (discretionary) awarded to the best entry from a film-maker up to 25 years of age.
